Page 1: 4 equal horizontal panels.

Panel 1: Ati Kuru Leads Tyler down a long, dark tunnel, lined with green-burning torches. His gruesome bulk casting horrible shadows. Tyler trails behind the monster.

Panel 2: From the front, we can see Tyler's frightened face.

Panel 4: They stand before a massive iron door, smooth with no discernable handle.

Page 2: Splash page

Panel 1: We see Tyler from behind, as he looks up at THE 9. Hideous creatures sitting on a tall dais in highbacked chairs. Descriptions TBD, but varied, some dressed in robes, other in suits, etc. He should have his hands up in the air in shock dread. Ati Kru is standing behind him, bemused expressions on his faces.

Page 3

Panel 1: #3 speaks first. He looks down at the tiny-looking Tyler with disdain.

#3: Someday, you will be one of us. But until that happens, you must fulfil the obligations of your duty.

Panel 2: Closer in on Tyler. He is doing his best to remain sane.

Tyler: My duty?

Panel 3: On # 5.

Panel 4: On #1.

Page 4:

Panel 1: Side view of the entire group: Tyler highlighted in the middle.

Panel 2: All of the 9 turns their heads to number 6.

Panel 3: We are behind #6, who rests his head on his hand as he looks down at Tyler.

Panel 1: From the front of Tyler. In his face.

Page 6:

Panel 1: #1 stands up.

Panel 3: Another angle, emphasizing #4.

#4: Death is always a choice.

Panel 4: On Tyler again, his head down, dejected, but not beaten.
