- The design needs to validate purchasing the parts
- The Design Review is in four weeks
 - o The design needs to work on paper
 - o The team needs to come up with tests to determine the validity of the design
- The team needs to hold off buying parts until a design is ready
 - o The budget can be solidified through this process
 - o The team needs to put their design ideas down on paper and prove them
 - o The project needs to be shown that it is organized
- The team is behind
 - o A design needs to be established now
- A meeting between the team and Dr. Hess will be conducted on Wednesday, October 21
 - o The team will update Dr. Hess on the design
 - o There will be a discussion over the DVP
 - o The team must prepare an agenda for the meeting at least 24 hours in advance

The team then gave the Snapshot Day presentation to Dr. Li, and Dr. Li then gave the team advice with regards to the presentation.

- There needs to be slide numbers for all the slides
- There should be a clear idea given of the goal and setting of the project
 - o Adding pictures will help with this
- The team should consider the accuracy of using GPS
- There should be specifics (such as budgets, project restraints, etc.) added to the presentation
- There should be a specific, technical plan for moving forward

Dr. Li presented logbook examples and advised the team on good logbook practices

- When uploading the logbook, keep the pages as one PDF
- Draw design ideas
- There needs to be a title page
- Make sure that there is a date, page number, and title for every entry
- Add "action items"
 - Notes of what needs to be done
- For every entry, start it on a fresh page

The team discussed about what to do before the meeting with Dr. Hess

- The team should have a meeting either on Sunday, October 18, or Monday, October 19
 - o Research should be done beforehand
 - Every member should draw up preliminary designs individually and then convene to determine the best design to move forward with
