## BACKGROUND

Kilowatts for Humanity provides renewable off-grid electrification
to developing countries using rooftop solar stations
Provided services:

- Refrigeration
- Device charging
- Offline servers



## VALUE PROPOSITION

Solar panels require continuous maintenance and monitoring

- Pyranometers are installed alongside solar panels
- Data in $\left(\mathrm{W} / \mathrm{m}^{2}\right)$ confirms energy absorption in panels

Monitors solar panel cleaning and maintenance needs
