Agenda item: Discuss ranges of fish sizes that will be going through the chute

Discussion: Determine of length width and size measurements for a range of fish sizes. Widths approximately ¼” for to .15 - .8 inches, smallest sized fish is ~ 1 gram or .15”. Widths of fish can be graded so that they can be in a smaller sized range of sizes using slats.
