Yifan Zhu: We are wondering is that the remote access prepared for us. Doctor Johnson, we have received your mail that seems like you' ve purchased some equipment.

Doctor Johnson: At least for the computer. That's the first one that you would connect to when you're coming into from the remote access. I think that the IT people already put a new computer in there. So basically, I'm paying for the one that they put in the computer that would actually be connected to the test equipment right now as an older computer, but it's gonna be replaced by a new one. The way it's gonna work is you're gonna connect to one computer with remote desktop, and then you're gonna go from that one to the one that's actually connected to the equipment. And possibly even be able to will eventually have been able to connect to other experiments as well. Hari was trying to use it the other day. It still was the communication was failing between the two computers. And so, I'm not sure what's going on with that right now. That's something that the it people and Abdallah, you might end up getting involved with that because Hari has some deadlines for another project. So, he can't spend a lot of time debugging this.

Abdallah: Do you want me to contact the IT guys?

Doctor Johnson: Right, talk to Mike. Probably say that. Because you were down there with some last week, some weren't you, or but just say that they were having communication problems, and we need to also get the interface set up and explain. So, the senior design team knows how to connect to it. So, the senior design team? Are you able to connect to the computer right now?

Yifan Zhu: Haven't tried. Do you want me do you? Do you want me to have a try?

Doctor Johnson: Yeah, all right. You can do it now or you can do it later and then just report to us. But I would like to see what you can and can't do right now.

Yifan Zhu: Hold on, we need to log in the uidaho vpn. Let's wait.

Yifan Zhu: It's connecting, let's wait for a while. It appears that it is configuring the remote interaction. Maybe we will still need to wait for a while.

Abdallah: Yeah, Yifan. I' ll contact Mike tomorrow. And see the how he is gonna like him. Do any progress. And also, as doctor Johnson said, you can't reply to the ticket to exuberant to him, to be in the law.

Joe: In my apologies for joining a little bit late for each other. For me.

Yifan Zhu: Thank you.

Doctor Li: It's, I think officially the break is for ungrated student and professors. Maybe per I'm a doctor Jonathan and correct me for my answer. Graduate student should be on campus. This is optional if you want to work. There's a more than welcome to continue to work, especially for our team. We have a lot of challenges, difficulty than normal students in U.S, so if you like to work, definitely just go ahead to work and if. You want to meet on Wednesday the same time. So, I look like everyone. Doctor Johnson, Joe, me, maybe. Abdallah. All available, maybe to come in. So, Doctor Johnson, and my answer is correct, because when I was in grade school, I heard from professor there. Spring break here is only for undergraduate student and professors, but not for graduate students.

Doctor Johnson: That was kind of a bad attitude for a professor. I guess the way spring break works is you don't have classes. So, you don't have regular class sessions. So, some students will use spring break as a time to catch up if they're behind on classes. If they are caught up and everything, They may take some time off. As far as like professors go, they the way that i've heard it described and it kind of makes sense is that the contract for professors starts the Monday of the week before classes in the fall semester. It ends this Saturday after gradual after the final's week in the spring semester. Basically, if you can get everything done, and working 20 hours a week, you can work 20 hours a week. If you get everything done working 80 hours a week, you work 80 hours a week, there's really no such thing as breaks for professors if they don't have things done. And for grad students, it's basically the same thing I like Abdallah paid 20 hours a week to be the TA supporting this class. If he wants to spend more time working on his dissertation research, but next week when he doesn't have classes and his senior design teams aren't as active, he's welcome to do that. But professors aren't really supposed to be requiring their grad students to work lots of extra hours unless they're paying them for it.
