- Adafruit trinket M0,
 - Uses Circuit Python programming or able to use Arduino IDE
 - Four mounting holes
 - o 12V controlled outputs

Maclean- Researched DC motors to acquire linear motion, small ones are expensive and in adjustable

- DC push-pull solenoid may be a good option (pulse 3mm when active), ~\$15, solenoid could be disposable

Lucas Discussion Items from his Weekend Meeting

- Toothbrush gave the best sanded surface, battery was able to last an appropriate amount of time
- Variable speed is important, prototype should refine old design and incorporate variable speed
- Recommending to production- outsourcing to production companies, use materials on hand for prototype
- Inner shaft/head stainless 316L, outer shaft- aluminum with surgical grade coating (stand up to saline solution)
- Recommended against on/off switch
