- Physical wiring + Simulink

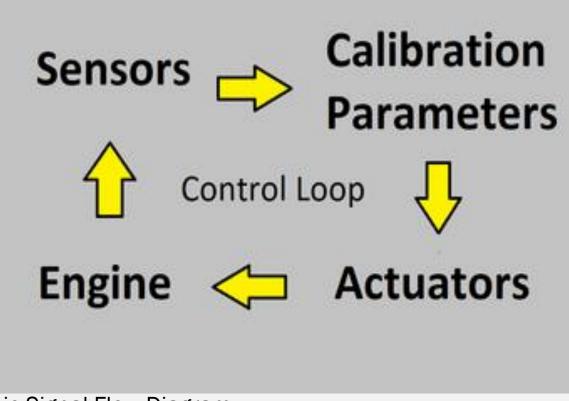






Objective

- Develop useful documentation









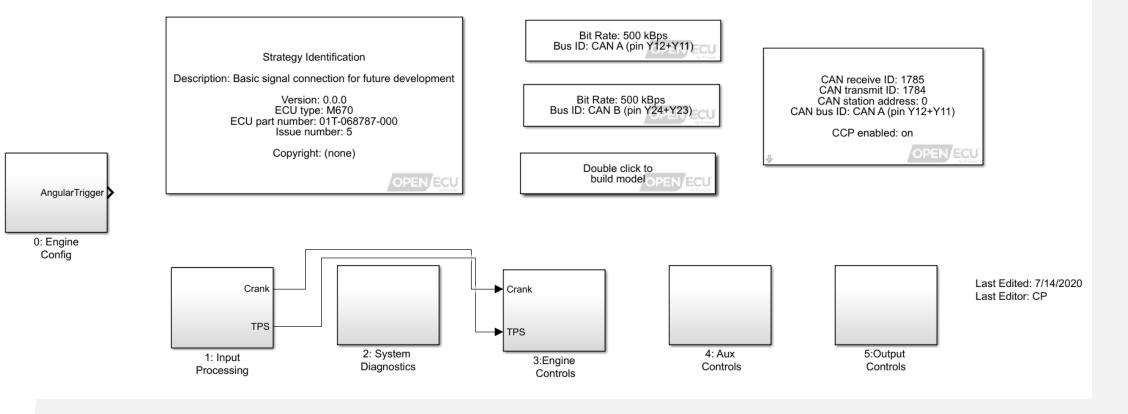
Product Requirements

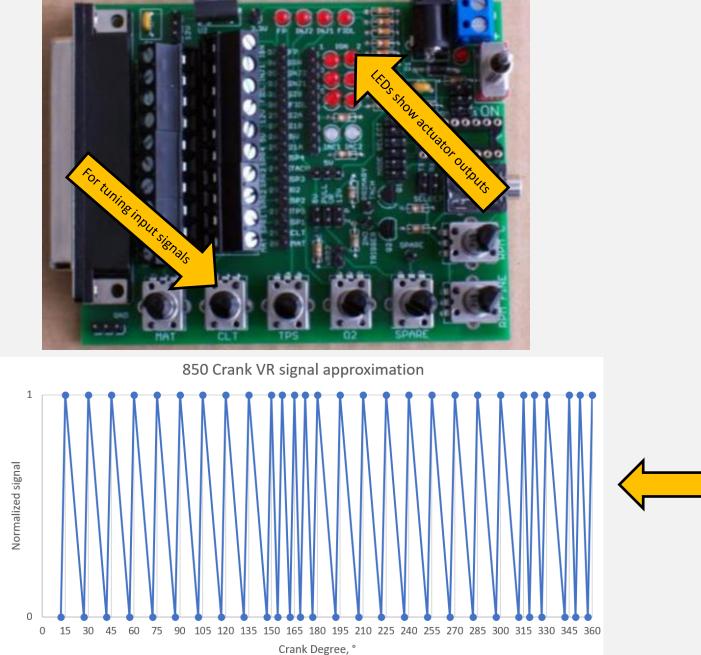
Validation
